On December 1, 1994, I received a complaint from [redacted] of [redacted], Nashua, NH. Mrs. [redacted] complained to me that she had purchased one cord of dry firewood for [redacted] and believed that she received green wood versus dry wood.

At approximately 11:30 am I responded to [redacted], Nashua and found a pile of wood located on her driveway which appeared to be fresh cut, green firewood. I advised Mrs. Duran that she needed to stack her firewood to determine whether or not she received a cord of wood. Deputy Sealer Richard Brown accompanied me to [redacted]'s home on the initial investigation. I used a moisture meter and randomly tested 30 pieces of firewood and determined the average surface moisture was 38.25%. I received the [redacted] slip from [redacted] which indicated a certified moisture content no greater than 11% to 18%, date tested November 25, 1994. [redacted] told me about her conversation with a male subject from [redacted] over the telephone, she was
